### Maths

This week we have been writing number sentences with addition and introduced word problems. We are working very hard to recognise and write our numbers to 100 in the correct order and recognising tens and units. Please encourage your child to practice writing their numbers, checking if they are the correct way around. For those looking for more of a challenge write the numbers in numerals and words. How high can you get? There are team points on offer.

### English

We are continuing with our story Stanley's Stick by John Hegley. We have been discussing adjectives and using them to create phrases with two descriptive words separated by a comma, e.g. *The soft, brown sock*.

It would be fun if the children can write a couple of descriptive sentences without giving away what they are describing in order for the class to guess. Please encourage them to bring their descriptions to share. Team points will be given for the best descriptions.

### Reading

Please read every day for a minimum of ten minutes, write a comment of your child's reading in their 'Reading Record' so that we are aware of your child's reading at home. Children can change their books when they are reading their book with ease and have an excellent understanding of the story.

### Spelling

All the Saplings, both year 1 and year 2 will have a test on the 28<sup>th</sup> September and will receive their new spelling list on that day.

### Show and tell
