Maths

This week we have been working with more and less and are now writing number sentences with addition. While you are cooking, laying the table or tidying up please chat to your child about adding numbers together. 'I have two toy cars and you have three toy cars, how many do we have altogether?' See if they can write a number sentence for the word problem. The children can record their number sentences and may bring them to school to show and earn some team points.

English

We are currently reading Stanley's Stick by John Hegley. We have been using our imagination and pretending our stick is anything from a magic wand, to a unicorn's horn to an incredibly special telescope. I would love the children to use their imagination to visit a special land and write a couple of sentences describing their land. Alternatively, they can draw a picture of their special land and label all the things that make it so incredible. Please encourage them to bring their descriptions and pictures in to share. There are team points on offer.

Reading

Please read every day for a minimum of ten minutes, write a comment of your child's reading in their 'Reading Record' so that we are aware of your child's reading at home. Children can change their books when they are reading their book with ease and have an excellent understanding of the story.

Spelling

The year 2 group were given a spelling list on Friday 14th September, they will write their first spelling test on Friday 21st September. All the Saplings, both year 1 and year 2 will receive a spelling list this week on Friday for their test on the 28th September.
