(3 points)

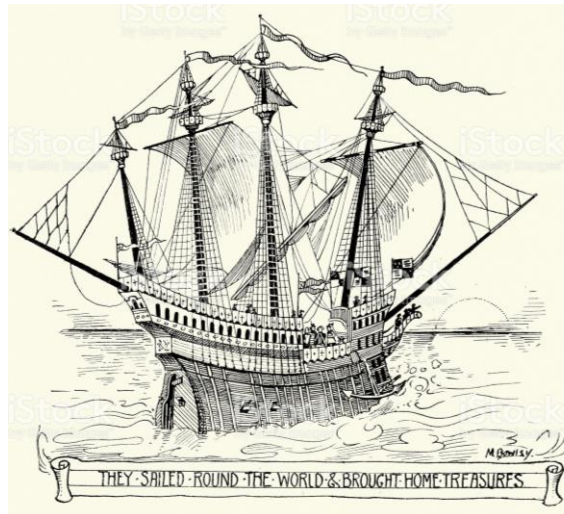
- ◆ Visit a local Tudor house/gardens/church. Take photographs. What evidence can we find that will give us more information about how the Tudor's lived?

Explore your mathematical skills:

(2 points)

- ◆ Using a map of the route that the Golden Hind would have taken, calculate the distances between different countries and the total distance of the journey.

Research:

(3 points)

- ◆ Research the different countries that were discovered during the time of the Tudors – mark on a world map
- ◆ Research famous explorers of Tudor times. Create character profiles/biographies
- ◆ Research foods or other items that were discovered in Tudor times through exploration e.g. potatoes, tobacco, peppers etc
- ◆ Research the events of the Spanish Armada in 1588 – create a newspaper report or a sailors diary outlining all of the different events
- ◆ Research famous shipwrecks from history including the Mary Rose and Titanic
