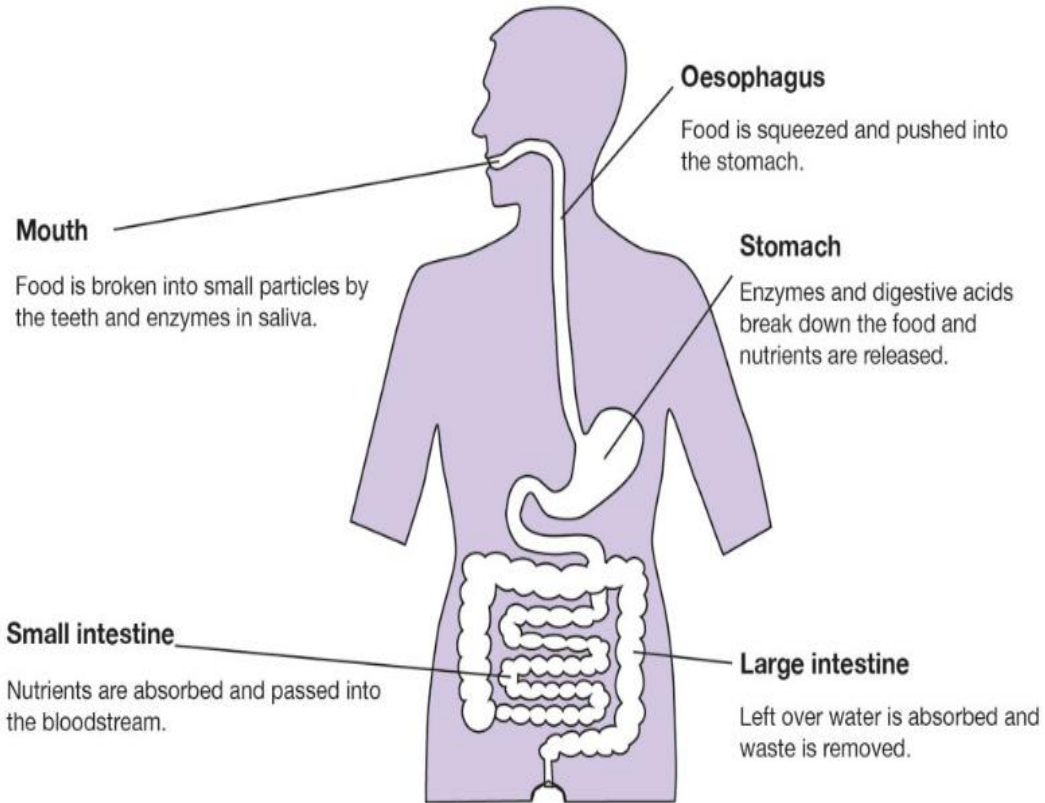

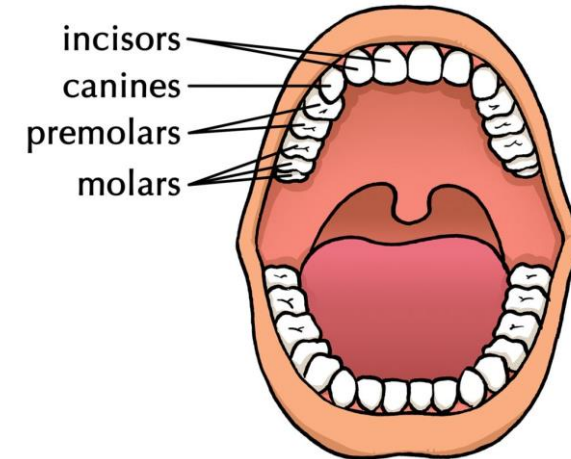

| The digestive system | It is made up of organs which break food down into protein, vitamins, minerals, carbohydrates, and fats, which the body needs for energy, growth and repair. |
| Incisors             | Teeth for cutting which have a flat front and a chisel-shaped back.  |
| Canines              | Pointed teeth which allow food to be pierced.  |
| Premolars and molars | Teeth which have rough, square surfaces which is ideal for chewing.  |
| Food chains          | The order in which living things depend on each other for food.  |
| Producer             | Living things which make their own food using sunlight (e.g. plants).  |
| Consumer             | Animals which get their energy from eating other living things.  |
| Predator             | Animals which kill other animals for food.   |
| Prey                 | The animals which predators kill for food.   |
