<p>z zebra</p> 	<p>Zip across, zag down and across the zebra.</p>	<p>qu queen</p>  <p>For q: Round the queen's face, up to her crown, down her robe with a flick at the end.</p> <p>Catchphrase: qu Quick, it's the queen! (not written on cards)</p>	<p>u umbrella</p>  <p>Down and around the umbrella, stop at the top and down to the bottom and flick.</p>
<p>ch cherries</p> 	<p>Catchphrase: ch Chew the cherries, children. (not written on cards)</p>	<p>c cat</p>  <p>Curl around the cat.</p>	<p>h helicopter</p>  <p>Down, up and over the helicopter.</p>
