
Maths

Communication and Language

Physical/P.E

Thread small objects onto a static point, move over, under, through and around equipment, hold a pencil between thumb and fingers, manipulate tools and equipment in one hand, use scissors to cut along a straight line, use a hammer to hit small targets, experiment with different ways of moving, testing out ideas and adapting movements. Please Note that P.E. will be on Fridays. The children will wear their P.E. kit to school and remain in it for the whole day.
